

Application Inventory - CMDB



- Needed for all aspects of modernization and ongoing maintenance
- Helps inventory and categorize EOL/EOS versions
- ➤ Key input to Business Case
- ➢ If you don't have a CMDB, get one!



Assess Tech Debt – Risk Scoring

CNA Business & Technology Risk Factors

Application Risk

Application Operational Risk

Overall health, stability, and currency of underling application frameworks/software and conformance with technology strategy

Application Mitigation Available

How feasible would it be to mitigate IT issues to support business needs, either through workarounds or replacement applications

Infrastructure Risk

The overall risk associated to underlying hardware and middleware as a result version currency (e.g. End of Life) and supportability



Business Risk

Business Value/Impact

Represents the level of value application provides to the organization as well as financial/resource impacts if issues with application was to arise

Business Strategy Alignment

How well the application supports the business strategy and the anticipated level of investment/change to support it

Security/Compliance Risk


Security risks associated to underlying infrastructure the application is running on, as well as any application-level security exceptions/vulnerabilities and data privacy/compliance considerations






Accelerators and Partners

 Al works best on "light" upgrades, less gain on full application refactoring and rearchitecting



 Use modernization effort to introduce test automation, CI/CD, monitoring, etc

SI's and Partners



 Select vendors carefully, both for services and COTS



 Utilize SI's for capacity and expertise, but don't hand over the keys and fully outsource



Scale SI's around core internal team



 Rethink your support model and skills for upgraded tech platforms
